New regulations for vehicle license renewals



SACCI wishes to bring to the attention of all members that no license renewal notices will be sent by the Dept. of Transport as was the case before. The reason for this, is that the Dept. of Transport is currently transferring the eNaTIS system to the Road Traffic Management Centre. A further new requirement is that motor vehicle owners now also have to provide proof of residential and postal address in order to renew the license discs. This was introduced on 2 November 2015 as a new policy / rule under Regulation 32A of the National Road Traffic Regulations.
