Nelspruit CBD City Improvement District boasts major reduction in crime

The statistics provided by J&M Security, the security partner of the Nelspruit CBD CID, shows a drastic reduction in crime for the Nelspruit CBD since the establishment of the CID and particularly during the months since March 2016, with no incidents of serious crimes reported.

Taking one of the most reported crimes, "Theft out of vehicle" as an example, it reduced from over 35 incidents in March to about 17 in May for the CBD area. In the CID area there was only one incident reported in May.

The successes are largely due to the swift action by the Security Ambassadors, better known as "Team Orange".

SA Unemployment situation rated the worst in the world

A recent global competitiveness report has ranked South Africa's unemployment as the worst in the world. The IMD report has ranked SA at number 61 on their list of 61 countries in terms of unemployment and poor labour practices.

Unemployment in SA rose to 26,7% in the first quarter of this year, a loss of an extra 355 000 jobs from the same time in the previous year. The International Labour Organisation (ILO) places SA in the 9th worst position in the world, but the worst overall when ranked among mature and developing economies.
