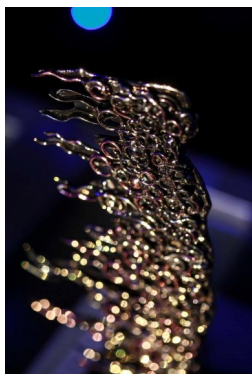

“Together we Can” - the inauguration of KLCBT President, Oupa Pilane



The inauguration of the new Kruger Lowveld Chamber of Business and Tourism (KLCBT) president on October 18, affirmed the shared vision of both business and government to create a prosperous and sustainable region.

Nelspruit-born Oupa Pilane (47) took over the reins from Dr Norah Fakude in the presence of top businessmen, local and regional government officials and KLCBT board and committee members.

In his inaugural address, Pilane told the audience, which included MEC Kholwane, that the KLCBT boasts men and women with the capacity to understand the dynamics needed to grow the region. “We all belong to the same picture of a puzzle; each piece is needed to complete the picture,” he said in championing a dynamic relationship between business and government. The sentiment was echoed by the MEC.
