Automated Tag payment system tested on N4 Toll Route

In keeping up with the times, Trans African Concessions (TRAC) has commenced rolling out the automated Tag payment system on the N4 Toll Route.

Automated Tag payment is an additional toll payment method for motorists with SANRAL tags fitted in their vehicles. However, there are currently no dedicated lanes for tag payments and all existing payment methods will continue to be accepted.

The initiative will be rolled out in phases, with a pilot phase for selected tag holders having already started during January 2017. The automated Tag payment pilot phase is effective at the following mainline ramp lazars on the N4 Toll Route:

Diamond Hill, Middelburg, Machado, Nkomazi, Donkerhoek, Cullinan, Valtaki and Ekandustria.
