Mozambican toll tariffs to be adjusted

Following confirmation from the Mozambican government, toll tariffs on the N4 Toll Route in Mozambique will be adjusted on 1 July 2017.

The toll adjustments will be applicable to both TRAC Moamba and Maputo Plazas, and will apply to all gazette vehicle classes as follows:

Class 1: Moamba MZN 150 and Maputo MZN 30

Class 2: Moamba MZN 380 and Maputo MZN 100

Class 3: Moamba MZN 1100 and Maputo MZN 350

Class 4: Moamba MZN 1500 and Maputo MZN 500

Public transport vehicles (taxis and busses) will however not be affected by the increase with their already discounted tariffs remaining in place.
