Please participate in the Tax Ombud's Questionnaire on Systemic Matters

In line with the Tax Ombud's mandate, certain systematic matters have been identified and relevant recommendations forwarded to SARS for consideration. In addition, following an increase in complaints received from taxpayers, the Tax Ombud conducted a systemic investigation into undue delays in the payment of refunds, and released the findings and recommendations to the public on 5 September 2017.

As part of their monitoring processes of the systemic matters identified, the Tax Ombud has prepared a short questionnaire that they would like to request our members to complete. The outcome will assist the Office to ascertain whether taxpayers/tax practitioners are still experiencing any systemic challenges identified.
