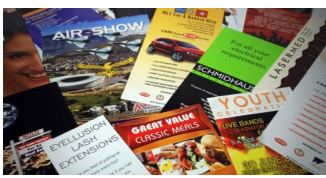

Theo Venter and Kruger & Partners give valuable insights on land issues

Co-hosted by Kruger & Partners, KLCBT presented an insightful networking breakfast event at Bundu Lodge yesterday. The guest speaker was renowned political analyst, Theo Venter, followed by a top legal and tax expert, Gideon Robbertse from Kruger & Partners.
