About the Forum

The inaugural **Alamein Africa Forum Go63** was established in response to a mandate from the African Union, which called for a permanent African Business Forum to convene biennially in Egypt.

Held in parallel with the 2026 African Union Mid-Year Coordination Meeting (Summit), this inaugural edition will convene more than 20 Heads of State and Government representatives, alongside senior leaders from leading international and regional financial institutions and key actors driving transformative change across Africa's most critical sectors, from infrastructure, trade and critical minerals to digital innovation, health markets and the emerging industries reshaping the continent's economic identity.

The aim is to become **the continent's premier gathering** where political power meets entrepreneurial prowess, bridging the established engines of African growth with the new sectors defining its future.

Co-organised by the Government of Egypt, Afreximbank, the African Union, and AUDA-NEPAD, the Forum brings together Africa's most influential decision-makers in an unprecedented alliance of public and private sector leadership.

This is not another conference: Go63 is the launchpad for partnerships, policies, and projects that will translate and update Agenda 2063's vision into concrete economic reality and define Africa's economic trajectory for the next decade.

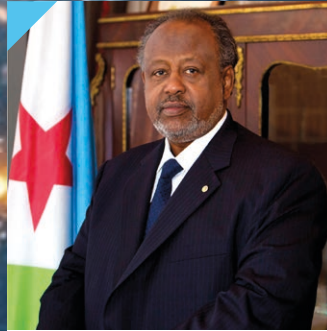

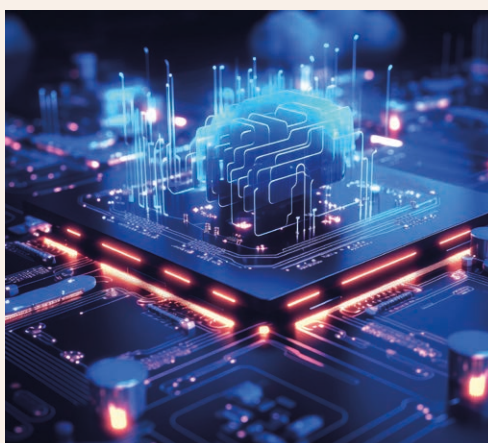

Alamein: A New Stage on the Mediterranean

Set on Egypt's Mediterranean North Coast, between Alexandria and Marsa Matrouh, Alamein is one of the country's most ambitious new urban destinations.

Recognised as the Capital of Arab Resorts, **Alamein is a flagship fourth generation smart city** extending across 60 kilometres of Mediterranean coastline, where contemporary urban planning meets one of the region's most striking seaside settings.

Conceived as a **next generation destination for investment, culture, and lifestyle**, the city is built around expansive public beaches, elegant promenades, landscaped parks, and a growing collection of cultural and hospitality landmarks.

In June, Alamein is at its most compelling. Warm sun, clear blue waters, and long Mediterranean evenings create an atmosphere that is both vibrant and refined. Easily accessible, the city is located approximately three hours from Cairo and 90 minutes from Alexandria by road, offering delegates the rare advantage of a high level international setting within immediate reach of Egypt's major urban centres.

Its long term development vision includes three universities, a dedicated city of arts and culture featuring an opera house and Roman theatre, and more than 10,000 hotel rooms across fifteen landmark coastal towers, reinforcing Alamein's growing appeal as a coastal destination designed for discovery, exchange, and exceptional experiences.
